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## BC Offshore Schools' Inspection

British Columbia offshore schools are inspected and certified by the BC government. Students registered in the BC Global Education Program at an offshore school receive instruction in English by BC-certified teachers. Graduates from the program receive a BC Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma).

A BC Ministry of Education Inspection Team of two has been visiting five schools over 10 days in China. The schools include Canadian Hefei No. 1 Secondary School, Canadian Secondary Wenzhou, Maple Leaf International School - Yiwu, Maple Leaf Foreign National School - Yiwu, and Grand Canadian Academy - Jiaxing.

These schools are operating at the leading edge of BC schools implementing the redesigned BC curriculum. It has, however, been an affirmation that Carver is further ahead in all areas including the development of curriculum planning documents, the latest assessment strategies, identifying core competencies and, most importantly, shifting the learning focus to student centered practices. This academic piece embedded in the framework of an authentic faith community serves our students and parents well as they continue to engage in and prepare for a life of transformation, service and faithfulness.

Carver Christian High School's staff and students certainly would be well prepared for a similar ministry inspection.

## Cultural Outreach Trips 2018: Mandatory Meeting on January 25

1. **Costa Rica and China Parents: Please arrive at 6.00 pm with photo ID for each parent. A notary will be at Carver to sign and stamp a document stating that you will allow your child to travel with Carver internationally:**

- Both parents must be present in front of the notary with photo ID and their child
- If parents are legally separated, both parents must be in front of the notary with photo ID and their child.
- If parents are legally divorced, a copy of the custody paper must be handed in and both parents come with photo ID and their child if it is joint custody. If it is solo custody, the custodial parent must come with child and photo ID.
- If a parent has passed away, a copy of the death certificate must be handed in and the living parent comes with photo ID and their child.

2. **All China, Costa Rica and Vancouver teams will have a parent and student meeting at 7.00 pm.** This is a chance to get all detailed information regarding the trip and to pray as a community for your individual child, the whole team and what God will do in the midst of each outreach trip 2018.
